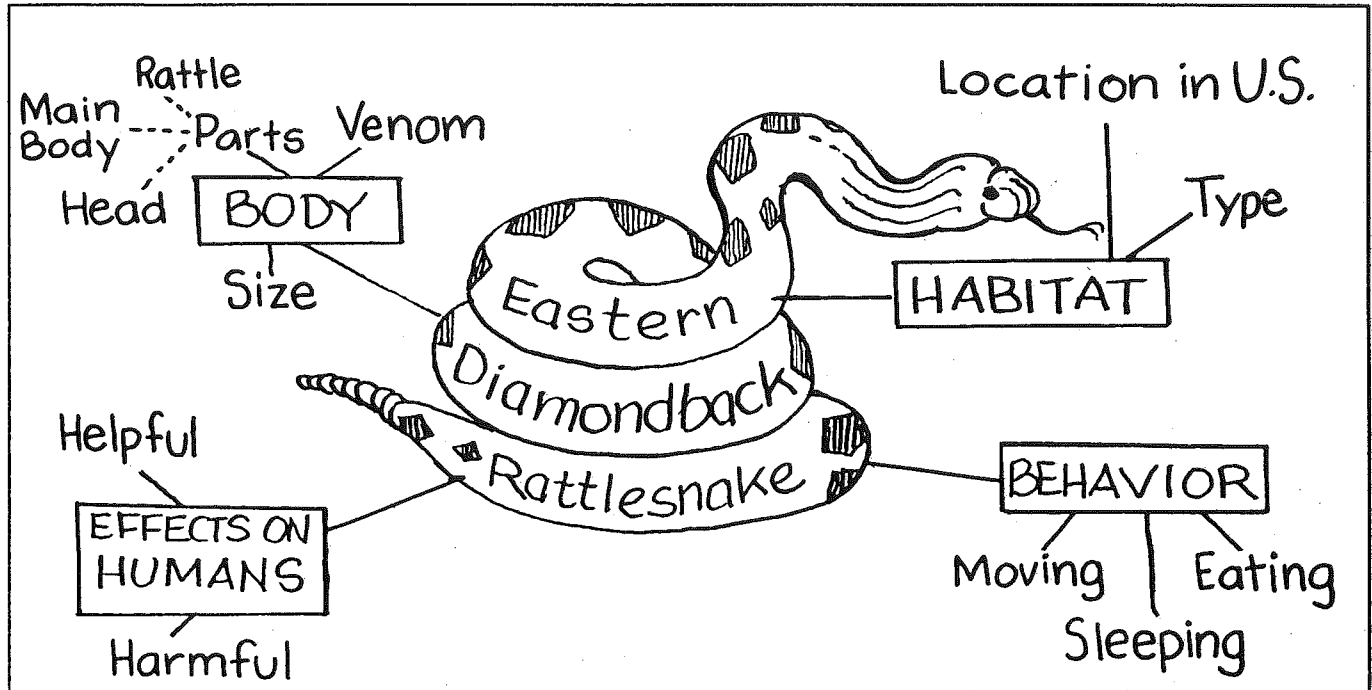


From Map to Outline
