

Possessive Nouns

A **possessive noun** shows ownership. Form the possessive of a **singular noun** by adding an apostrophe (') and -s.

Example: girl's dress Mrs. Davis's car

Form the possessive of a **plural noun** that ends in s by adding only an apostrophe (').

Example: dogs' tails girls' purses

Form the possessive of a **plural noun** that does not end in s by adding an apostrophe (') and -s.

Example: the men's cars children's toys
