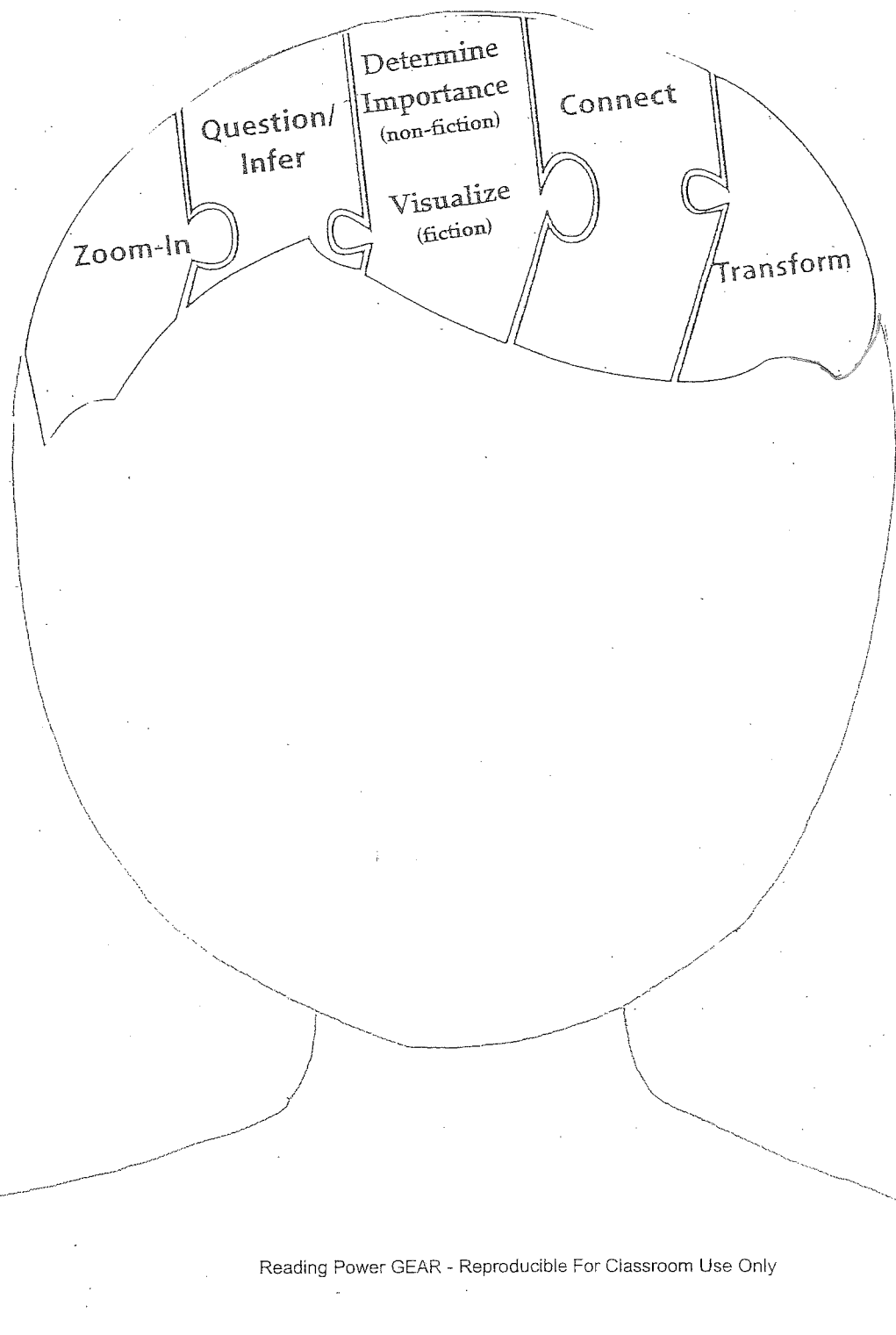

Non-Action reading skills

Zoom-in - look at text features in a book.

- help you understand the text ideas
- help you locate information
- usually the first thing you do.

Question / Infer - check your understanding by asking question about what you read if you are confused

- May need to make an educated guess of the answer based on the text (add your own ideas to what you read)
- We may have to re-read, define, or read ahead for answers.

Make connections - Use your own experiences (text to self), what you know of the world (text to world), what you've read or seen on TV shows / movies (text to text) to help you understand the text.

Determine importance - sort out the main idea from the details.

- make notes in your own words.
- makes you aware of what your reading purpose is.

Transform our thinking - change or expand your thinking based on new information from the text.

Visualize - make pictures in your head
- a movie
